Sub: - Engagement of Event Management Agency

Section - 1 Background of the Event:

National Gallery of Modern Art, Delhi will hold an exhibition 'Jai Hind', at the Belvedere House, Kolkata. The exhibition has been designed as an amalgam of the rich legacy of the Freedom Movement and the role played by Netaji.

125 young Kolkata based artists will attend a four-day workshop (January 16-20) organized by the NGMA and create four-hundred-metre-long narrative canvases designed like the traditional Patua scroll paintings to portray stories from the life of Netaji. These will be displayed from a height of 20-25 feet along with smaller individual canvases and sculptures created in the workshop.

The exhibition will be opened for public viewing on 23 January on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Netaji.

Section - 2 Objective:

In order to provide and ensure proper arrangements to conduct the artists' workshop and mega-exhibition, NGMA intends to engage an event management agency to manage the entire event with the scope mentioned in this document.

Section - 3 Scope of Work:

Overall scope of work includes: -

- Preparation of ground for artist-camp.
- Fabrication of exhibition space/installation props (indoor and outdoor).
- Procurement of 4 hundred metre canvases and other smaller canvases.
- Procurement of art material for painting and sculpture.
- Food and refreshments for 150 artists during a four-day workshop and the final program on 23rd January.
- Travel and boarding of curatorial team (10 artists and scenographers).
- Creation of a 15 feet sculpture of Netaji.
